- Gulf Coast Growth Ventures brings innovation to the Coastal Bend, while enhancing U.S. manufacturing infrastructure and producing materials that make high performance, everyday products possible.
- Gulf Coast Growth Ventures is a petrochemical complex that produces the building blocks of everyday products used around the world right here in the Coastal Bend.
- Polyethylene can be used in the production of medical supplies, food packaging, agricultural film and building and construction materials. Monoethylene glycol can be used to manufacture polyester clothing, paints and automotive coolants.
- The facility includes a 1.8 million metric ton ethane steam cracker that produces ethylene, which then feeds three derivative units: one monoethylene glycol unit and two polyethylene units.
