- MEI Solutions, supported the construction of the Mickey Leland International Terminal (MLIT) project at George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH). The project will replace the existing Terminal C North domestic concourse with a new international concourse configured to accommodate up to 6 widebody aircraft or a combination of 8 aircraft of a widebody/narrowbody mix.
- This new concourse, D West, will include modern finishes, large restrooms, high ceilings and expanded concessions and customer dwell areas. The project also includes a refurbishment of the existing Terminal D departures areas inclusive of mechanical, electrical and life safety systems and a new interiors aesthetic to match the finishes at the D West concourse.
- The project commenced with demolition of the C North concourse (built in 1980) in 2020 and will complete for passenger use in the first half of 2023.
